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As of 4/30/15 consolidated revenues for year to date (10 months ending 4/30/15) was 6,371,453 which is 1,036,480 less than a year ago on 4/30/14. Consolidated profit and loss statement for year to date (10 months ending 4/30/15) shows a consolidated net income of 136,952 as compared to a net loss of (193,316) a year ago on 4/30/14 an increase of 330,271 as compared to a year ago. GLAD's net (loss) was (129,443), DAHC's net (loss) was (11,210), LifeSigns' net income was 277,605, consolidated net income 136,952.

- deaf. These classes are critical for deaf who have not acquired ASL and there are no other classes in LA.
- 27 LAUSD assumed that deaf students could go to mainstreamed ABE classes using interpreters; however, it
- reflects ignorance on its part because deaf adults without language are ASL ready to use interpreters.
- 29 The instructors will be losing their jobs as well.
