### IV. C.E.O.'S REPORT

5 G.L.A.D is nearing the end of the fiscal year (June 30, 2017). G.L.A.D has been focusing on statistics and

- 6 making sure that our contract obligations are exceeding the goals of the number of consumers served. As
- of today, G.L.A.D is meeting goals except for few areas of services here in LA and G.L.A.D has until June
- 8 30, 2017 to pull up the statistics. Some of statistics may have been entered incorrectly by classifying some
- 9 services under different areas of services like advocacy instead of independent live skills. C.E.O. is
- 10 confident that G.L.A.D will meet goals by June 30th.

# 11 **Public Relations (P.R.)**

- 12 C.E.O. thanked the board for postponing the "Love is Never Silent" event from June 3rd to October 14th.
- 13 It was postponed due to unforeseen conflict in community events. For instance, some people are going out
- of the country on tours during that week, two schools for the deaf will have graduation that day, and Deaf
- 15 Bikers will reunite in Big Bear on June 3, 2017. C.E.O. personally contacted sponsors and donors about
- 16 postponement.
- On a separate note, Ka-Yun Chan, G.L.A.D's PR Coordinator and C.E.O. flew to Denver to interview
- Joanne Greenberg the author of the book "In This Sign" (the movie is called "Love is Never Silent"). It
- was a great trip to meet the author to interview her and she talked about the book. This videotape will be
- shown at the event. G.L.A.D is honored to be chosen to be given the painting by Rich Rush that will be
- 21 unveiled at the event.

- 23 Health Education
- 24 Teen Pregnancy Prevention
- Our work with students will exceed the goals under the contract Information and Education (CA).
- 26 G.L.A.D submitted a budget amendment to the agency in March awaiting the final approval from them.
- 27 HIV Prevention Program
- 28 Based on Center for Disease Control guidelines and Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) it is
- 29 hopeful that G.L.A.D will be recommended for a 12 month extension starting July. G.L.A.D anticipated
- 30 getting a word from the agency by May 15th. To this date, we have not received word.
- 31 It is expected that G.L.A.D will meet its goals with the required number of students for individual sessions
- for a 30, 60, and 90-day follow up sessions.
- 33 Advocates have been busy with cases, mostly doing document translation because more consumers are
- 34 getting official letters. Often these letters are about benefits like financial, health and right to work. With
- 35 the warm weather, it is more challenging to find shelters that will remain open for consumers who are
- 36 homeless. G.L.A.D is in the process of developing a coalition working with agencies nearby to refer
- 37 consumers to food banks, shelters, and emergency funding.
- Office of Deaf Access (O.D.A.) has been transferred back to the Department of Specialized Services.
- 39 O.D.A. will have a meeting with directors end of June which C.E.O. plans to attend and represents four
- 40 centers (G.L.A.D, C.O.D.I.E., O.C.D.E.A.F., and T.C.G.L.A.D). O.D.A. is in the process of finalizing
- 41 2017-2018 contracts for four centers so we can continue providing services beyond June 30th.
- 42 Employment Development Division (E.D.D.)
- 43 E.D.D. program has exceeded contract goals even for the month of April. Twenty-three interviews were
- 44 conducted between potential employers and consumers. It is G.L.A.D's goal for consumers retain their
- employment beyond 90 days. For the month of April, nine consumers kept their jobs beyond 90 days. It
- showed that some consumers might have been let go due to seasonal hiring period.
