- 1 Financial reports as of 1/31/12 was given to the finance committee presented by our controller with the
- 2 following information Consolidated profit and loss for year to date (seven months ending 1/31/12) shows
- a loss of (24,636) as compared to a loss of (32,080) a year ago.
- 4 Consolidated year to date revenues as of 1/31/12 was \$3,477,274 which is \$78,349 less than prior year.
- 5 GLAD's 1/31/12 net loss was \$(50,066) as compared to prior year net loss of \$(47,784).
- 6 LifeSigns's 1/31/12 net income was \$47,278 as compared to prior year net income of \$25,715.
- 7 DAHC's 1/31/12 net loss was (21,848) as compared to prior year net loss of (10,011).

## IV. CEO'S REPORT

- Hughes report that we are using a new broker to check into health insurance packages for GLAD.
- We can only apply for grants from private foundations every 3-4 years. Some foundations do not allow
- organizations to re apply for funding for two or three years in between funding periods.
- 17 It will be a short report as we had our meeting three weeks ago. It is with my pleasure to announce that we
- have been awarded \$150,000 from the Weingart Foundation to replace the funds we lost. I got the word
- 19 this afternoon. We will work out details next week After I get the official letter from them.
- 20 . It will mean that we will be able to bring back some programs we lost due to decrease in funding.
- 21 GLAD had a staff meeting today from 9 am to 3 pm. It was great and we will have another meeting in
- 22 May. We had our Sexual Harassment training for all staff given by an attorney. Then we broke up in
- 23 groups by departments for further in house trainings. The advocates were trained on what to do if angry
- 24 clients come in with a gun or a weapon. It is also a great opportunity for staff from all of our offices to
- 25 mingle.
- 26 Human Resources
- We have a total of 71 employees as of today. There are two job openings which are Job
- 28 Developer/Interpreter for the Pacoima EDD office and a Staff interpreter for LA.
- 29 LifeSigns (LS)
- Number of Filled Interpreter Requests 871
- 31 Cancellations 117
- 32 No Interpreter Available 36
- 33 Emergency 212
- We will be adding an Interpreter position for the Kern County based in Bakersfield in the very near future.
- 35 Human Services
- 36 We are seeing an increase of consumers who are now homeless or staying with friends or shelters in the
- 37 Kern County. The city of Bakersfield has minimal resources available, especially in the area of Alcoholics
- 38 Anonymous and Substance Abuse for consumers with no interpreters at their meetings. Bakersfield is also
- 39 short on interpreters.
- We have been working with consumers locating their records from schools so they could have the proof
- 41 that they had schooling in order to receive services, communicating with the court system to dismiss some
- orders due to communication issues, assisting consumers in translating driver's education manual in
- 43 American Sign Language. LifeSigns will have a legal workshop on Feb 24<sup>th</sup> for staff and freelance
- 44 interpreters.
- 45 *EDD*
- We are seeing some consumers returning back to receive placement services due to being laid off from
- 47 seasonal jobs during holidays. We managed to make 20 job placements during the month of January.
- 48 Health Education
- 49 Our case management shows a great need to be continued. We had 20 unduplicated consumers in a seven
- 50 month period. The number of appointments with duplicated consumers are 133. We are seeking funds to

- 1 continue this program as funding will expire in June. We are looking into maybe having a program for
- 2 how to dealing with being overweight. Schultz suggested a cancer program.
- 3 Public Relations
- 4 Filming
- 5 More film companies are interested in our facility for filming. We have several agents that handle the
- 6 interesting parties. We had our first facility rental booking through CAST Locations. We will also sign up
- 7 with EastWest Locations since we are non-exclusive. House of Blues (HOB) will be on September 30<sup>th</sup> in
- 8 the evening as it will be a night club. It is nice because it is our 10<sup>th</sup> year anniversary and we are able to
- 9 have the entire day for set-up to avoid similar incidents last year. Last year we were late because there
- was another event before us and they had to clean up the place.
- We have posted a save the date to our e-News/website and currently working on the event banner for our
- 12 home page. We are waiting to confirm a meeting date with Ken Paves. We are working on sponsorship
- levels and will have them ready to promote in March.

- 15 SIGNin the Street is the name of the upcoming event at Downtown Disney that will occur March 17<sup>th</sup> thru
- 16 18<sup>th</sup>. SWIS (See What I'm Saying) has chosen GLAD to be the beneficiary of a percentage of ticket sales
- for the weekend's film sales. SWIS will be hosting a pre-screening on Tuesday, Feb 21<sup>st</sup> for Disney
- 18 executives and Cast members.
- 19 I will be going to Sacramento on February 28<sup>th</sup> to meet with the staff from the Office of Deaf Access
- 20 (ODA) in the Department of Social Services to discuss the budget modification policy, future of ODA, and
- 21 RFP in the fall. All of us from 8 agencies will be present at the meeting in the morning then we will have
- our meeting in the afternoon following the morning discussions. GLAD, OC, TRI, and CODIE has a new
- contract monitor working on our contracts so it will be an opportunity to meet her, too.
